IN HONOR OF C. Scott Vanderhoef

Throughout his 20 years as Rockland County Executive, Vanderhoef has been a loyal friend to Rockland veterans, providing programs and services to meet their needs. Even before Vanderhoef became County Executive, he was dedicated to veterans' causes and was instrumental in establishing a not-for-profit organization, NY Vets, to help establish the Camp Shanks Museum in Orangeburg.

During Vanderhoef's first term, the County partnered with the U.S. Veterans Administration to establish an incredibly successful veterans clinic here in the County. Before 1996, fewer than 300 veterans were using VA outpatient services because the closest VA hospital was more than one hour away. Today more than 400 veterans receive health services at the County clinic in New City. The clinic will remain one of Vanderhoef's most enduring legacies.

Under Vanderhoef's leadership, the County began offering many new programs and services for veterans and the families of active duty soldiers. The Veterans Maintenance Support Program offers free emergency home repairs to the spouses of servicemen and women deployed overseas. Pro Bono New York offers pro bono legal services to veterans and their families and the Veterans Court gives judges the option of keeping non-violent, recently returning veterans out of jail. In addition, Rockland's Return the Favor Program gives veterans a discount at about 4,00 participating merchants.

Vanderhoef also oversaw the restoration and dramatic expansion of the Frederick Loescher Veterans Cemetery on Brick Church Road. The cemetery now provides our veterans with a more dignified final resting place.

For two decades, veterans and active duty soldiers have had a loyal supporter, friend and advocate in County Executive C. Scott Vanderhoef. Your appreciation to Scott can be expressed by honoring him with a listing in our Breakfast Journal, which will be distributed at the Breakfast.
